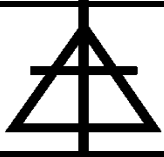

**Voice of the Martyrs** – Dieny Donkersgoed: PAKISTAN – Shahzad Masih (26) and his pregnant wife, Shama (24), were disposing of garbage in the village of Kot Radhakisha when Shama allegedly burned pages from the Quran. A frenzied mob consisting of hundreds gathered demanding their death. Ultimately, the young couple were thrown into a brick kiln where they were burned to death. It was later determined that they had been falsely accused. Many who have participated in the attack have been set free and others never charged. Pray that God's peace will rest on the couple's family as they continue to grieve. Also, that His Grace will be evident in those who participated in this attack

Statistics show that 1 in 6 women in the church have had an abortion. If you have a heart for women who have had an abortion as part of their story and are interested in learning more about journeying alongside them, the **Lethbridge Pregnancy Care Centre will be offering Living in Color post-abortion recovery training on May 4th and 5th**.
