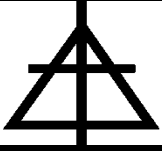

Voice of the Martyrs – Dieny Donkersgoed: NIGERIA -: April 14th marked the fifth anniversary of an attack which shocked the world and devastated the lives of many in Nigeria. On that day, members of the Boko Haram militant group attacked a girls' school in Chibok, forcibly removing at least 276 young students, most of them Christians. After five years, the whereabouts of 112 students remain unknown. According to a report more than a thousand children have been abducted. Also, at least 2,295 teachers have been killed and more than 1,400 schools destroyed. Please continue to remember the missing girls and other innocent victims praying that they will be protected strengthened to stand firmly spiritually and will be freed.
