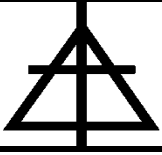

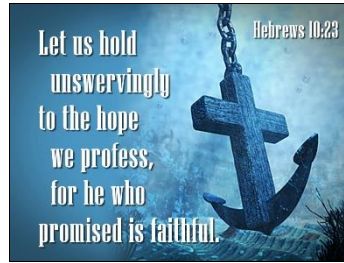


Community Worship in the Park - August 26th at 10:30am

Voice of the Martyrs – Dieny Donkersgoed: **INDIA** – Christians residing in the Gadchiroli district of Maharashtra state have been warned by fellow villagers of the intent to close one church every week. Since June, more than a dozen homes belonging to Christians have been attacked across five villages. The believers have been told that, unless they renounce their faith, the water supply will be cut off and food subsidies will be stopped. In a recent incident that took place Gallu Kowasi was badly beaten in the village of Kospundi by locals who were demanding that he abandon his faith. Several others have faced threats of death or expulsion. May they rest in the assurance of God's blessing and love in the midst of persecution.
