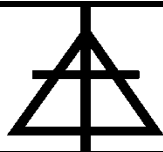

Voice of the Martyrs – Dieny Donkersgoed: **EGYPT** - As churches in Egypt prepared for Christmas celebrations, terrorists near Cairo plotted an attack against the worshippers. Multiple bombs were placed on a roof near a church in the city. A Muslim imam in a mosque saw what was happening and alerted the police. As the bombs were being disarmed, one of them detonated -- accidentally killing an officer by the name of Mustafa Abid.
