




Voice of the Martyrs – Dieny Donkersgoed: **INDIA** - Christians in India have frequently faced opposition from neighbours as well as authorities. A growth in Hindu nationalism has exacerbated the problem. According to Evangelical Fellowship of India, incidents have risen to a never-before level in Uttar Pradesh, India's most populous state. An incident that took place late October, where a group of believers were meeting in Agra when a mob of 40 to 50 people forced their way in, many of the gathered Christians were beaten, and seven of them left in serious condition. Please uphold these Christians in India in your prayers. Pray that those affected will stand firm in their faith. Also, that Christians in various denominations will support and encouraging each other.
