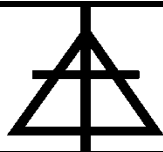

**Voice of the Martyrs** – Dieny Donkersgoed: **NORTH KOREA** - In an attempt to monitor defectors, North Korean secret police agents have been studying the Bible. The purpose is for them to be able to gain rapport and trust with defectors in China and South Korea. In so doing, they hope to gain information on the whereabouts of other defectors, as well as ways to track and monitor them so that they can be reported to Chinese authorities, who will then arrest and repatriate them to North Korea.
