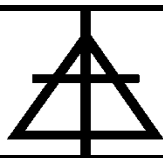

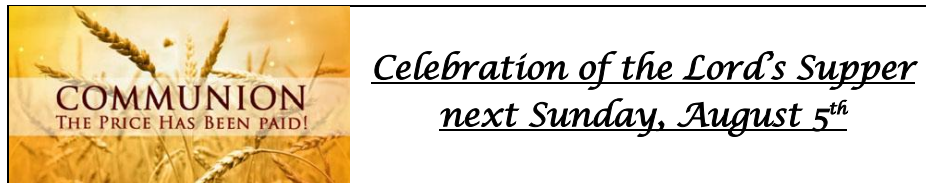

**You are invited to a concert on Saturday August 18th at 7pm at Maranatha CRC to hear the music of Jeremy Benjamin.** The CRCNA and World Renew have commissioned Jeremy to tour across the country, sharing his gift of music with CRC churches. He will be teaching and recording the voices of thousands to be included in his song "I Am Not My Own", based on the Heidelberg Catechism Q&A 1. At each location, Jeremy will sing with congregations and students and record their rendition of the song. The recordings will contribute towards a 10,000+ voice choir echoing the words together that "I Am Not My Own." Since the confession of Heidelberg Catechism Q&A 1 is that "we are not our own" and thus are "wholeheartedly willing and ready to live for him", the event will involve an opportunity for us to support both World Renew and the Canadian Food Grains Bank. All monies raise at the concert on the 18th and worship service on the 19th will be split between the two worthy causes. Our goal is to help contribute to the \$500k goal for this tour. **Voice of the Martyrs** – Dieny Donkersgoed: **IRAN** – Ramiel Bet Tamraz was arrested along with four converts from Islam when security officials raided a picnic northeast of Tehran. Although the five Christians were interrogated and eventually released, Ramiel and his friend were charged with "acting against national security". Ramiel and his friend were both sentenced to four months in prison. The young man's father, Victor Bet Tamraz is presently appealing a ten-year prison sentence for similar charges. And Ramiel's mother, Shamiram Isavi Khabizeh is appealing a five-year sentence for "acting against national security". Please remember this pastoring family as they face legal challenges and that the courts will treat citizens fairly and allow worship.
