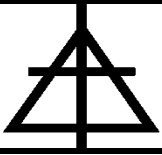

**Voice of the Martyrs** – Dieny Donkersgoed: **ALGERIA** –Several churches throughout Algeria have been closed by authorities in recent months resulting in calls to the government for equal treatment for Protestant Christians. Places of worship for non-Muslims are required to be built for the purpose of worship only, but worship in homes or apartments require approval. Along with the closures, individual Christians and pastors have also faced harassment and fines for "proselytising." Pray that Christians in Algeria will stand firm despite pressure from the forces around them and also that they may be allowed to practice their faith in freedom and peace.
