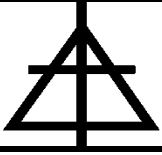

Voice of the Martyrs – Dieny Donkersgoed: **India** – The North Indian state of Uttarkhand is now the seventh state to pass legislation restricting religious conversions, particularly from Hinduism to Christianity. This law carries a jail term of up to two years. Experience in various areas of India indicates that similar legislation has frequently been applied unjustly against Christians, particularly among those who are considered by Indian society as low-caste Dalit people. Unwarranted accusations are often used to harass and restrict Hindus from converting away from their religion. Pray that the governments in India will respect religious rights of all its citizens and that Christians will continue to reach for the message of hope in Christ.
