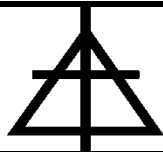

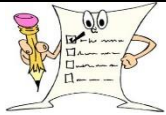

People in the village of Tamchi report continuing attacks against them There are rumors that local militants plan to destroy the homes of Christians in Tamchi and two other nearby villages. In the most recent incident, a Muslim from the village was also beaten by ten people because he was a good friend of Eldos. Remember those in Kyrgyzan who are wrongly mistreated.
