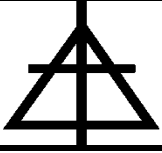

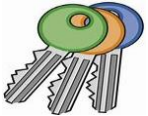

Voice of the Martyrs – Dieny Donkersgoed: **SRI LANKA** – The church in Sri Lanka has been facing increasing violence and discrimination in the past year. From January through to September it has been reported 67 incidents. In one example, a mob of about 100 people from surrounding villages attacked a church building in Beliatta, demanding an end to worship services and threatening the lives of the pastor and his family. While Christians have often been able to respond with forgiveness and move on, the persecution can be discouraging as well.
