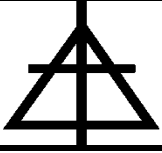

Voice of the Martyrs – Dieny Donkersgoed: **Turkey** – Staff members of Santa Maria Catholic Church in Trabzon were alarmed when they found the smoldering remains of a homemade pipe bomb in their church. Recently there have been increased threats and attacks against Christians of various denominations in Turkey. Other intimidation tactics used against believers include broken windows and signs, Islamic slogans painted on walls, and a burned New Testament left in front of a church. There have also been a number of recent news reports expressing very critical views towards Christians, with the seeming intent to influence public opinion against the church. Turkish Christians are requesting prayers for safety and courage for the faithful believers.
