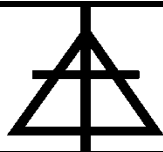

Deacon Report:

The last few collections in September- Safe church \$606.00 - Global Missions \$803.50 - Local Missions this includes Kayla Stolk - \$613.50 through ACCI Adventive Cross-Cultural Initiatives and Annette Lievaart -\$613.55 through Reach Beyond Canada

The budget contributions have been low the last few months. As of the end of September we are about \$71,000 below budget. Please consider the programs and ministries the budget funds support.

This week, October 7th, we support St Vincent de Paul. In the last few years we have been working with them in helping those less fortunate within the community in a variety of ways. Next week, October 14th, we support SABC — Southern Alberta Bible Camp, a ministry operated by the Evangelical Free Church but supported by many.

For Monday's Thanksgiving Day collection, we have 7 causes selected: The Lantern Community CRC in Calgary, The Taber Food Bank, World Renew, Taber Christian School, CIAM Radio Station (The Harvest), Canadian Foodgrains Bank and Foundation for His Ministries. Funds will be divided evenly unless specified.

Small Group Bible Studies: We are excited about new opportunities to join a small group Bible study. It has been a number of years since we have tried this, and are hoping that many people will sign up to join one. Small groups are a great way to grow closer in your relationship with Christ, to get to know others in the church and to have a good support group. There are sign-up sheets in the back with various options to sign up for. We will need to have someone lead these as well, so if you are interested in leading, please talk to Pastor Ken. The times and dates of the small groups are yet to be determined, but we are looking at alternating Sunday evenings here at church, with the options for other groups to meet at homes or on another night. Please indicate behind your name which night works best for you.

We rejoice with SABC that their Capital Campaign Vision 75 for the expansion of their facilities is ready to begin the first phase: tear down of the old dormer, and then replace it with a new one: Target Date for the demolition is set for March, 2019, assuming that the contractors haven't already filled their schedules through and beyond that month. If all goes as planned, the new facility should be ready by the end of the year 2019. This year they were almost able to match their record registration of 1720 Campers that was set in 2017: they missed it by one. It was great to hear from the Activities Director, Tania Martens, share some "God Stories" that highlighted the summer's rigorous schedule during the Board Meeting last week. 62 Campers made a commitment to Jesus for the first time this summer. Please keep Vision 75 in your prayers. SABC is seeking a Water Front Director for next year. So if you know of anyone who might be interested in filling that position, please encourage them to inquire.

Voice of the Martyrs – Dieny Donkersgoed: **ERITREA** – When a peace agreement was reached between Eritrea and Ethiopia, hopes were high that the new-found peace could also lead to a relaxation of religious oppression in Eritrea. On a flight from Ethiopia to Asmara Pentecostal evangelist Surafiel Demssie was one of the passengers who arrived in the capital city. He held an informal evangelistic street meeting. Family members were initially told that five Eritreans had been arrested for blocking the street and would be released shortly. It is common for prisoners to never face formal charges, despite lengthy imprisonment under horrific conditions. May the Lord give great strength and courage for these innocent prisoners who are imprisoned for their faith.
