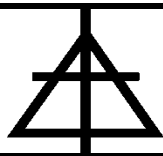

Leaders needed!

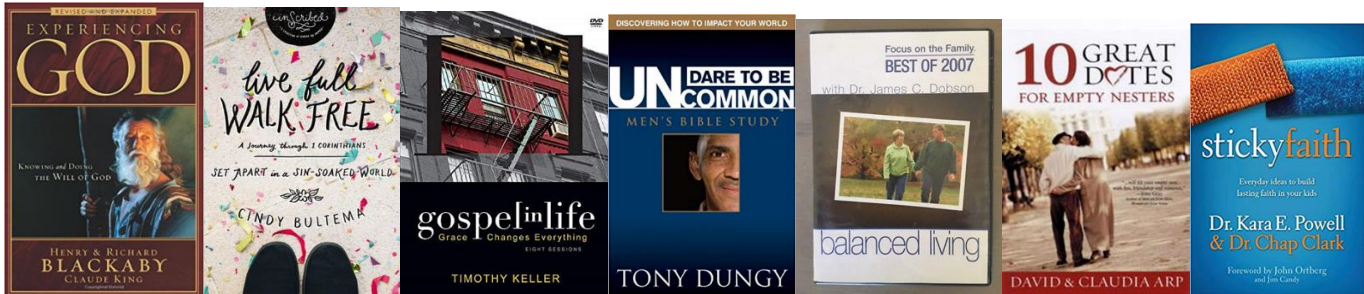

Voice of the Martyrs – Dieny Donkersgoed: **BURMA** – For years the northern state of Kachin has faced armed conflicts between the government military and rebel independence. In January, we reported that soldiers of the government troops were also targeting Christians by destroying church buildings, as well as raping and murdering innocent women. While the world's attention has been focused on the ill-treatment of Rohingya Muslims by the Burmese army a new report has been released, documenting the atrocities against the predominantly Kachin Christian population facing, similar treatment. Pray that help will arrive swiftly and help for thousands of starving people and churches will be allowed to provide for those in need.
