We offer our condolences to the Stolk family in the passing of Rob Stolk last week. May God surround them with his loving arms of comfort.

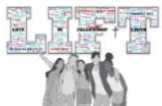
We offer our condolences to the extended Visser family in the passing of Agnes Slomp on Wednesday.
