Refugee Committee Update: Please continue to pray for Sakhi and his wife, Fatima, as the refugee committee assists them in the process of being reunited in Canada through the One-Year Window (OYW) program. We are thankful to share that Fatima's ID card has now been issued, allowing the application process to move forward. She is currently staying with her brother in Kabul while waiting for her passport to be issued. Because the OYW application must be submitted within one year of Sakhi's arrival in Canada, there is some urgency to completing the process in time. Please pray for protection, favour, and smooth processing of documents, as well as peace and encouragement for both Sakhi and Fatima during this season of waiting and separation.

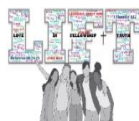
