God has given us a heart and a passion for the rural poor of Nicaragua. It's a beautiful thing when God brings all the resources together to complete His mission. Since 2011 we have built trust with the farmers and have grown the agronomy team necessary to provide the strategies to overcome poverty for the long-term. Not just material poverty that we see all around us everyday, but also the poverty of hopelessness that comes from limited opportunities and lack of knowledge of God's working in our lives. Teaching biblical values and principles are an important component of our programs. Based on a more technical approach to crop production – quality seed, proper nutrition, applying best practices, marketing opportunities – we have managed to greatly affect incomes for hundreds of farm families in 70 rural communities. Farmers are experiencing yields of up to 3 times the national average.
