Your support makes it possible for families and individuals of all ages to gather for a weekend of fellowship, worship, and building relationships within our church.

**Dear First CRC, Greetings from Kenya,** I have a deadline to get this out - in a week I get on a plane, and I should probably let you know I'm coming. For those of you cheering that's it my time for home ministry assignment (HMA) just wait... not yet. That will be next year. This is just a quick visit to see family and some friends. So you might see me, but I apologize I can't see everyone. I am looking forward to seeing friends and family, a Tim's Iced cap and a break from work. My itinerary has a few days in Ontario, then a few days in Edmonton and lastly time in Southern Alberta before I fly back again. I pray that all the logistics come together to allow this trip to go smoothly.

A challenge with leaving for a few weeks is leaving my respiratory trainees behind. We are almost halfway through the training - it has been a joy to see these individuals learn and already contribute in meaningful ways. A few weeks ago, I got a message from one of our doctors who had been on peds call overnight. The Resp. trainee who was on a regular nursing shift in NICU was able to pull out the neopuff and help the patient. This is a piece of equipment that the staff had training on before but now it is really starting to take off in use. There are also challenges with a program and I appreciate your prayers - one of my students recently lost his mom after a long battle with cancer. Another student is struggling academically but with one on one teaching, is catching up. While I am gone, each student has been assigned a lecture topic to teach, and they will be supervised by my RT colleagues at the CTC. Hopefully, through teaching, even more learning will take place, and it will help release some of the teaching burden while I'm away.

After 13 years at Tenwek, I have gotten used to the good-byes that come in spring and summer but it's still hard. Some years are tougher than others, and this is a tougher one. We have many families who are leaving on home assignment or have completed their 1-3 year term. Thanks for praying for our community as we go through this season of good-byes and anticipate the hello's that will come as we welcome new and returning families in August.

Lastly, this has been one of the hardest weeks for Tenwek. A week ago one of our young Kenyan Doctors, Bella, collapsed and required CPR. Despite 3 days of ICU care at the Cardiothoracic Center she was unable to recover and passed away. Bella was a part of my intern bible study when she was an intern and I worked with her regularly. She was a good friend with so many of our staff and trainees. Our staff counsellors have been busy. I have given and received many hugs as we all support each other. Please pray for those impacted, especially her family and those closest to her.

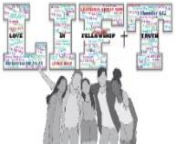
