

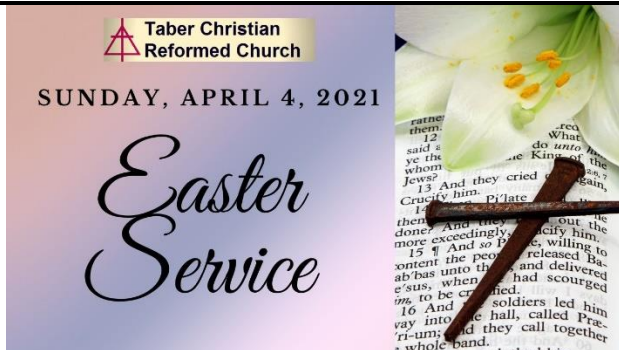

**On March 22, 2021 at the congregational meeting,** the Calling Direction Committee was able to present the requests and responses they received from the congregation through various meetings and feedback methods on the direction the church wanted to go regarding staff positional fulfillment. At this meeting, two positions were discussed that reflected what the congregation is looking to expand and growth within our church. The first one is a "Director of Ministry and Outreach". This position is meant to fill the vacancy from the previous Associate Pastor. This position will oversee the YEC and all the church programs that fall under this ministry. It will also oversee the Outreach programs and support the committees dedicated to these causes. The second position is a part-time "Director of Care" position. This would be a new position in our church. In this position, the Director would formulate and look after care groups and various committees that fall under the Care Ministry. This would include the Fellowship Committee, Seniors Fellowship, Funeral Reception, new members etc. Council reviewed these recommendations and has approved that that they be brought forward to the congregation for a vote on the new Director of Care Position to decide if the church would like to continue its growth in this area as recommended by the congregation.
