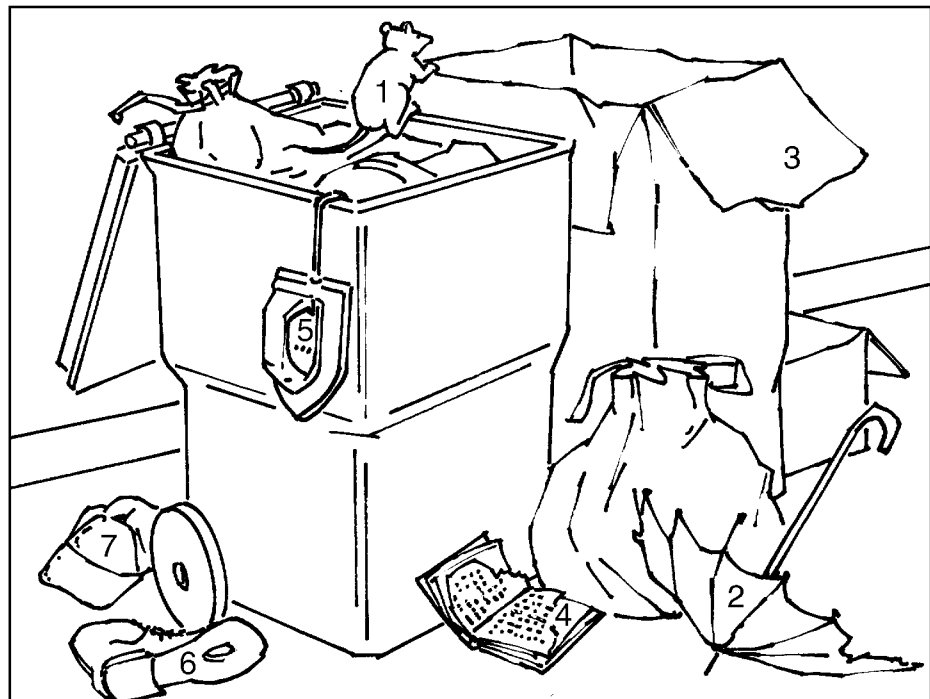

Write the first letter of the numbered items in the picture.

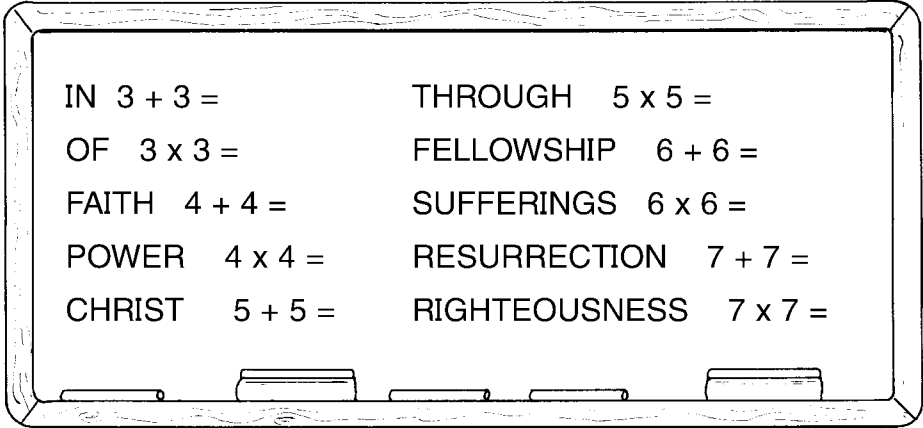
