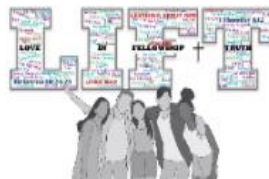
Please be in prayer for Bill Vanderwal as he was admitted to the Taber Hospital this past week fighting an infection.
