Check Once memorized	<p align="center"><b>PASSAGES to MEMORIZE - from the NIV</b>  <i>-feel free to memorize a different translation than the NIV if you prefer!!</i></p>
	<b>Philippians 1:6b</b> He who began a good work in you will carry it on to completion until the day of Christ Jesus.
	<b>Philippians 1:9-11</b> And this is my prayer: that your love may abound more and more in knowledge and depth of insight, <b>10</b> so that you may be able to discern what is best and may be pure and blameless for the day of Christ, <b>11</b> filled with the fruit of righteousness that comes through Jesus Christ—to the glory and praise of God.
	<b>Philippians 1:20</b> I eagerly expect and hope that I will in no way be ashamed, but will have sufficient courage so that now as always Christ will be exalted in my body, whether by life or by death.
	<b>Philippians 1:21</b> For to me, to live is Christ and to die is gain.
	<b>Philippians 1:27</b> Whatever happens, conduct yourselves in a manner worthy of the gospel of Christ.
	<b>Philippians 2:1-2</b> If you have any encouragement from being united with Christ, if any comfort from his love, if any common sharing in the Spirit, if any tenderness and compassion, <b>2</b> then make my joy complete by being like-minded, having the same love, being one in spirit and of one mind.
	<b>Philippians 2:3-4</b> Do nothing out of selfish ambition or vain conceit. Rather, in humility value others above yourselves, <b>4</b> not looking to your own interests but each of you to the interests of the others.
	<b>Philippians 2:5-8</b> <b>5</b> In your relationships with one another, have the same mindset as Christ Jesus: <b>6</b> Who, being in very nature God, did not consider equality with God something to be used to his own advantage; <b>7</b> rather, he made himself nothing by taking the very nature of a servant, being made in human likeness. <b>8</b> And being found in appearance as a man, he humbled himself by becoming obedient to death—even death on a cross!

	<p><b>Philippians 2:9-11</b>  <b>9</b> Therefore God exalted him to the highest place and gave him the name that is above every name,  <b>10</b> that at the name of Jesus every knee should bow, in heaven and on earth and under the earth,  <b>11</b> and every tongue acknowledge that Jesus Christ is Lord, to the glory of God the Father.</p>
	<p><b>Philippians 2:12b-13</b> Continue to work out your salvation with fear and trembling, <b>13</b> for it is God who works in you to will and to act in order to fulfill his good purpose.</p>
	<p><b>Philippians 2:14-15</b> Do everything without grumbling or arguing, <b>15</b> so that you may become blameless and pure, "children of God without fault in a warped and crooked generation." Then you will shine among them like stars in the sky.</p>
	<p><b>Philippians 3:7-9</b> But whatever were gains to me I now consider loss for the sake of Christ. <b>8</b> What is more, I consider everything a loss because of the surpassing worth of knowing Christ Jesus my Lord, for whose sake I have lost all things. I consider them garbage, that I may gain Christ <b>9</b> and be found in him.</p>
	<p><b>Philippians 3:10-11</b> <b>10</b> I want to know Christ—yes, to know the power of his resurrection and participation in his sufferings, becoming like him in his death, <b>11</b> and so, somehow, attaining to the resurrection from the dead.</p>
	<p><b>Philippians 3:12-14</b> Not that I have already obtained all this, or have already arrived at my goal, but I press on to take hold of that for which Christ Jesus took hold of me. <b>13</b> Brothers and sisters, I do not consider myself yet to have taken hold of it. But one thing I do: Forgetting what is behind and straining toward what is ahead, <b>14</b> I press on toward the goal to win the prize for which God has called me heavenward in Christ Jesus.</p>
	<p><b>Philippians 3:20</b> But our citizenship is in heaven. And we eagerly await a Savior from there, the Lord Jesus Christ</p>
	<p><b>Philippians 4:4-5</b> Rejoice in the Lord always. I will say it again: Rejoice! <b>5</b> Let your gentleness be evident to all. The Lord is near.</p>
	<p><b>Philippians 4:6-7</b> Do not be anxious about anything, but in every situation, by prayer and petition, with thanksgiving, present your requests to God. <b>7</b> And the peace of God, which transcends all understanding, will guard your hearts and your minds in Christ Jesus.</p>
	<p><b>Philippians 4:8-9</b> Finally, brothers and sisters, whatever is true, whatever is noble, whatever is right, whatever is pure, whatever is lovely, whatever is admirable—if anything is excellent or praiseworthy—think about such things. <b>9</b> Whatever you have learned or received or heard from me, or seen in me—put it into practice. And the God of peace will be with you</p>
	<p><b>Philippians 4:11-13</b> I have learned to be content whatever the circumstances. <b>12</b> I know what it is to be in need, and I know what it is to have plenty. I have learned the secret of being content in any and every situation, whether well fed or hungry, whether living in plenty or in want. <b>13</b> I can do all this through him who gives me strength.</p>
	<p><b>Philippians 4:19</b> And my God will meet all your needs according to the riches of his glory in Christ Jesus.</p>
